Introduction

CO₂ is found in centuries-old ice in Antarctica, way before any industrialisation on Earth. Carbon emissions and, therefore, atmospheric CO₂ levels have varied enormously over thousands of millennia and the earth is still here and extremely habitable.

Scientists
