

How to Playing European Roulette

Roulette gamblers who want to take a tour of Europe to play in the casinos may not expect the roulette table here. The reason: there is a big difference between Europe and American roulette. There is also a difference in how players play their game in Europe.

European Roulette Basics

The European Roulette wheel contains 37 slots numbered from 1 to 36 including zero. It also contains a ball and a layout on which the player places the bets. It either covers a single number or a group of numbers. The number at which the ball spins around the wheel is the winning number. The rules of European Roulette are identical for both the free and real versions of the game.

Tips for Gamblers

Gamblers need to purchase the chips, which come irrespective of any denomination. They are simply a color. The moment the roulette player makes the purchase, the dealer offers the denomination.

Notice the absence of any double zero, which creates a better odd for players, who place the bet. It gives odd/even, red/black or 19-36/1-18 in their favor.

Find out whether the casino offers them en prison features. This rule is enforced when gamblers bet their money on an even number and the ball lands on zero. Then the bet freezes. It returns if the next spin causes the gambler to win the bet. In some casinos, the dealers return half the amount that the gamblers bet.

Gamblers of European roulette should confirm that their inside bet total is the table minimum. In addition, even the outside total has to be a lowest amount.

It is important that roulette gamblers place an outside bet, as it offers lower returns. Bets are available in black or red. Additionally, gamblers of roulette can also bet on even or odd numbers, columns or rows. As a gambler, you need to decide on the inside bet. Dealers place them on number combinations beside one another or on individual numbers in the board.

In the occasion of a 4-corner bet, the gambler places the chip in a way that it touches the 4 numbers on the corners. In case it hits a number, the payoff starts from to textarea. If the roulette gamblers place the chip on a single number and then make their bet, they can pay from \$ 35 to \$ 1.
