

Casino Stud Poker vs. Caribbean Stud Poker

Is there any difference between online casino Stud Poker and Caribbean Stud Poker? Casino Stud Poker is the British version of Caribbean Stud Poker and although it is virtually an identical game there are some subtle differences. Caribbean Stud Poker differs slightly in the United Kingdom, and most parts of Europe. In the U.K. the game is officially known as "Casino Five Card Stud Poker", and the main variant in play is that not all online casinos have the jackpot prize. In Caribbean Stud Poker there is always side betting allowed (usually a dollar or so per play) on a progressive jackpot that pays out for a certain hand. The UK sites and casinos that do have a progressive jackpot usually call the game "Casino Jackpot Five Card Stud Poker". In UK casinos the game (that traditionally does not have side-betting or a jackpot) is also casually referred to as "Casino Stud Poker".

The basic rules of the game, no matter what you want to call this exciting game are the same in the UK as the US, although the payouts differ. In a game of British online casino Stud Poker the maximum bet is generally £100 on the ante and £200 on the raise, and all payouts are paid on the raise, meaning the maximum payout can potentially be £10,000. Another element that makes internet casino Stud Poker different than Caribbean Stud Poker is that in a UK casino a Royal Flush pays at the same odds, 50:1, as a Straight Flush. In Caribbean Stud Poker a Straight Flush is only 10% of the pot usually. Of course all of these prize amounts can vary depending on which casino you are playing at.

Another difference between Caribbean Stud Poker and Casino Stud Poker has to do with the style of shuffling. A game of Caribbean Stud Poker always has a progressive jackpot and a machine always shuffles the cards. In the UK casinos, the game has more of a personal touch. There is usually no jackpot so a croupier who shuffles them by hand deals the cards.

If you are playing a Casino Stud Poker hybrid (a game that does include a jackpot) then all hands that have bet a wager on the jackpot must be turned over and shown to the dealer after the conclusion of the play. However if the player has not wagered on the jackpot prize then his cards are left turned over and face down on the table.

If you are playing online casino Stud Poker in a live British casino the table may also operate differently than the kind of table you would see on a Caribbean cruise ship. The British Casino Stud Poker tables have plastic circles embedded in the felt. You place your wager on these and the croupier presses a button so that these circles light up and they stay lit until the croupier removes the chips. This is how the croupier tells which players are wagering and which ones are not.
