

Comparing Online Bingo with Online BlackJack

Both blackjack and bingo are much-loved games across the world. Their online counterparts are also growing rapidly in popularity throughout the internet community. In fact, online blackjack is now the second most popular online game. There are several reasons why these games have attracted such a large following. These include the state-of-the-art gaming software now available, the convenience of playing these games on the internet and of course, the cash and other prizes that can be won.

Comparisons between Online Bingo and Online Blackjack

There is a certain amount of intelligence and strategy involved when playing online blackjack. Consequently, many online casinos offer two modes of play -- easy and difficult -- to suit both beginners and experts. The rules of the game are very straightforward. You play against a dealer singly, or as part of a multi-player session. Two playing cards are dealt to both you and the dealer. The aim is to achieve a total of 21 before the dealer, without going beyond that number. In most online blackjack, the game is played as follows: to be dealt an extra card, press the 'HIT' button. To refrain, press the 'STAND' button. The cards are valued as described: ace counts as 1 or 11; cards 2-9 are valued as indicated; cards 10, Jack, King and Queen all count as 10.

Many people are familiar with the rules of land-based bingo. Online bingo is very similar. Although online bingo is predominantly a game of chance and luck, you can affect the ultimate outcome with speed and accuracy. The first player to complete the grid pattern correctly is the winner. The main difference between land-based and online bingo is the use of the Auto-Daub function found only in online bingo. This is a feature that helps to eliminate the confusion that can be caused in multi-player bingo sessions. The Auto-Daub feature automatically crosses out the numbers when they are called or displayed. It even calls out 'BINGO' on completion of the pattern.

Playing Online Bingo and Online Blackjack Safely

When deciding to register and open an account with an online casino, make sure you choose one that operates legitimately. It should have a clearly-displayed licence on its website.

Before making a deposit, read the terms and conditions meticulously. Pay particular attention to special promotions and bonus offers.

Many online players make deposits and payments using a major credit card which is generally a more secure way of transferring money. Paypal is also a good alternative.

Choose an online casino which has membership of a regulating body such as the Interactive Gaming Council or the e-Commerce and Online Gaming Regulation and Assurance. Affiliations or endorsements by the abovementioned associations are equally effective.

Many online players participate in chat rooms and message boards. They do this to develop social relationships with their fellow gamers. These chat rooms also provide essential information about the online casinos such as if the casino is slow to pay-out or has poor customer service.

The internet has made it possible to bring up both good and poor reviews given to online casinos by their customers. Spend time reading these reviews. Also research their ratings and comparisons with other online gaming establishments.

Lastly, be certain that your computer is able to accommodate the downloads needed to start playing. Most online games are simple and quick to download but others are more complicated. Some games do not require downloads at all. However, many online casinos are happy to help resolve your technical difficulties. To reassure their online customers, customer support is usually available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week via email or telephone.

Conclusion

The most important thing to remember when playing online bingo or online blackjack is that you should treat it as a form of entertainment, not as a means to riches. Gamble responsibly, within your limits. Learn the rules, practise regularly and acquire all the skills necessary. The online experience of playing these games -- complete with realistic sound effects and graphics --can make this a fun way to spend your leisure time. Both bingo and blackjack in their online forms can be played either singly or in a multi-player environment. Of the two, bingo is probably more inherently sociable than blackjack with the topics under discussion at any one time in a bingo chat room being in all likelihood more diverse than those to be found in blackjack where the focus is likely to be more on the game itself.
