- Burg Angermund built in the 14th century
- Schloss Eller built in the 14th century
- Schloss Kalkum built in the 18th century
- Schloss Mickeln built in 1843
- Schloss Heltorf
- Schloss Garath

### Leipzig

Leipzig is the biggest city in east Germany and was founded in 1165. In 1409 it became the centre of book-printing-art and Napoleon was beaten there by Austria and Russia. The national library of Germany is also located in Leipzig. There are a lot of nice things you can visit here like:

- The Egyptian museum
- The Bach-museum
- The old stock exchange
- The zoo and much more.

### Munich

This city was founded in 158 by duke Hendrik de Leeuw. Munich has a very old centre with a lot of museums like the Alte Pinakothek, the Neue Pinakothek and the Pinakothek der Moderne.
